INTERNATIONAL DELEGATE POLICY

(Applicable to all Non-Indian Passport Holders)

1. PURPOSE AND LEGAL NATURE OF THIS POLICY

This International Delegate Policy (“Policy”) governs the participation of all international delegates, observers, and attendees holding non-Indian citizenship who register for, attend, or otherwise participate in **Invictus Model United Nations 2.0** (“the Conference”).

This Policy is a **legally binding condition of participation**. By registering for the Conference, making payment, accepting an invitation letter, or attending any Conference-related activity, the participant confirms that they have read, understood, and agreed to be bound by this Policy in its entirety.

Failure to comply with this Policy may result in **denial of registration, revocation of participation, removal from the Conference, and/or reporting to relevant authorities**, without any obligation of refund or compensation.

2. APPLICABILITY AND SCOPE

This Policy applies to all international participants including, but not limited to:

- Delegates
- International observers
- Independent participants
- Visiting faculty or trainers
- Any person attending the Conference on the basis of a non-Indian passport

This Policy applies to conduct and circumstances occurring:

- Prior to arrival in India
- During the Conference
- At Conference venues
- At accommodation facilities arranged or suggested by the organizers
- During transit or transport arranged by the organizers
- During social events, informal gatherings, or side events connected to the Conference
- After the Conference, insofar as disputes or liabilities arise from participation

3. NATIONALITY-BASED REGISTRATION RESTRICTIONS

Due to regulatory, diplomatic, logistical, and internal security considerations, **registrations from the following nationalities are strictly barred and will not be accepted under any circumstances:**

- Pakistan
- Bangladesh
- Turkey
- China

This restriction applies **irrespective of residence, dual citizenship, or alternate travel documentation**, unless expressly approved in writing by the Organizing Committee at its sole discretion.

The Organizing Committee reserves the absolute right to:

- Cancel registrations discovered to fall under the above nationalities
- Withhold invitation letters
- Deny participation without refund
- Report false declarations where legally required

4. IMMIGRATION, VISA, AND ENTRY RESPONSIBILITY

4.1 Sole Responsibility of the Delegate

All international delegates are **solely and exclusively responsible** for:

- Identifying the correct visa category
- Applying for the visa in a timely manner
- Ensuring accuracy of documentation
- Complying with Indian immigration laws and regulations
- Ensuring passport validity and travel permissions
- Ensuring lawful entry into and exit from India

Invictus MUN and its organizing body **do not act as visa sponsors, immigration consultants, guarantors, or facilitators** under Indian law.

4.2 Invitation Letters

Invitation letters, where issued:

- Are provided **solely for academic/event participation reference**
- Do **not** constitute sponsorship, endorsement, or guarantee of visa approval

- Do **not** create any legal obligation on the organizers toward immigration authorities or the delegate

The Organizing Committee bears **no responsibility** for:

- Visa rejections
 - Delays
 - Partial approvals
 - Entry denial at ports of entry
 - Deportation or removal
 - Overstay penalties
 - Immigration questioning or investigation

4.3 EU and USA Delegates – Specific Notice

Delegates holding passports from the **European Union, United States of America, or other Western jurisdictions** are expressly informed that:

- Visa approval is subject to Indian sovereign discretion
- Prior travel history or visa-free access to other countries is irrelevant
- Indian immigration authorities may deny entry without providing reasons

No refunds, compensation, or liability shall arise in such cases.

5. COMPLIANCE WITH INDIAN LAWS AND REGULATIONS

All international delegates must strictly comply with:

- Indian Penal Code
- Local and state-level laws
- Public order and safety regulations
- Laws relating to narcotics, alcohol, and controlled substances
- Cyber, speech, and public expression laws
- Laws governing assemblies and demonstrations

Any violation may result in:

- Immediate termination of participation
- Eviction from venues or accommodation
- Notification to law enforcement authorities
- Permanent blacklisting from future conferences

The Organizing Committee shall **not be liable** for the personal legal consequences of any participant's actions.

6. PROHIBITED CONDUCT (NON-EXHAUSTIVE)

International delegates are strictly prohibited from:

- Possessing, consuming, or distributing illegal substances
- Engaging in physical or verbal violence
- Sexual harassment or misconduct
- Political demonstrations outside committee mandate
- Disrespect to national symbols, religions, or cultural practices
- Misrepresentation of identity or nationality
- Recording or publishing content that violates privacy or law

Violation of this clause may lead to **summary removal without notice**.

7. HEALTH, MEDICAL FITNESS, AND INSURANCE

By participating, the delegate confirms that:

- They are medically fit to travel internationally
- They assume full responsibility for their physical and mental health
- They are strongly advised to carry valid international health insurance

The Organizing Committee:

- Is not a medical provider
- Does not guarantee medical assistance
- Does not assume responsibility for illness, injury, hospitalization, allergic reactions, or medical emergencies

Any assistance provided is purely humanitarian and does not create legal liability.

8. ACCOMMODATION AND TRANSPORT DISCLAIMER

Where accommodation or transport is:

- Suggested, coordinated, or facilitated by organizers
such facilitation **does not constitute legal responsibility or custody**.

The Organizing Committee shall not be liable for:

- Theft, loss, or damage of personal belongings
 - Acts of third-party service providers
 - Incidents occurring at accommodation facilities
 - Incidents during transit

9. MEDIA, DATA, AND IMAGE CONSENT

All international delegates consent to:

- Photography
- Videography
- Audio recording
- Live streaming
- Promotional and archival use of media

Such consent is:

- Worldwide
- Royalty-free
- Perpetual

No claims may be raised regarding image rights, publicity, or data usage consistent with Conference operations.

10. DISCIPLINARY AUTHORITY

The Organizing Committee reserves full discretion to:

- Investigate conduct
- Impose sanctions
- Remove participants
- Terminate participation

Decisions of the Organizing Committee are **final and binding**, and no appeal shall lie beyond internal mechanisms.

11. GOVERNING LAW AND JURISDICTION

This Policy shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the **laws of the Republic of India**.

All disputes shall be subject to the **exclusive jurisdiction of the courts located in [Insert City/State, India]**.
